Syphilis Treatment - Benzathine Penicillin G-LA (Bicillin® L-A)

ATTENTION: EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT STAFF, PHARMACY

As per the Canadian STI Guidelines, the following constitutes the first-line treatment for syphilis:

- Primary, Secondary and Early Latent: Long-acting Benzathine Penicillin G (Bicillin® L-A) 2.4 million units intramuscular as a single dose.
- <u>Late Latent and Tertiary</u>: Three (3) weekly doses of Long-acting Benzathine Penicillin G
 (Bicillin® L-A) 2.4 million units IM.

Bicillin® L-A comes in pre-filled syringes (as pictured). Each pre-filled syringe contains 1.2 million units of medication. A complete dose requires TWO syringes administered IM bilaterally to the left and right ventrogluteal (preferred) muscle or dorsogluteal muscle.

Penicillin G sodium and other types of shortacting or controlled-release penicillins are <u>not</u> effective in treating syphilis.

Bicillin® L-A can be ordered through Public Health. An order form for Bicillin® L-A and other free publicly funded STI medications is attached to this email and also available on our website. Also attached are a *Syphilis Treatment Info Sheet* and STI Treatment Reference Guide.

Grey Bruce Public Health encourages Emergency Departments to order and keep at least one dose of **Bicillin® L-A** on hand to assist in facilitating the timely treatment of syphilis. Patients who did not receive the appropriate treatment should be contacted for retreatment.
